

# **Quick Start Guide**

Sending a Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate from Profile for Mac

Electronic submission (e-Lodgement) of Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate is possible only through the HealthLink Online Forms from HISO-capable electronic medical record (EMR) systems.

The Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate online form has been designed to make it easier for you to complete and submit a medical certificate for your patient electronically to Work and Income. This guide has been created to show you the key steps involved in completing a Work and Income medical certificate within Profile for Mac.


### 1. Launch the WINZ Form

Click on the Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate online form (WINZ Form) from the Profile for Mac toolbar menu.



## 2. Open the patient record

Search for the patient and click on OK to open the WINZ form on the context of the selected patient.






## 3. Complete the Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate

The Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate will display and is very similar in format and functionality to a DHB eReferral form.

Complete the relevant fields under each tab on the left. You can park the form if you want to work on it later.



# 4. Submit the Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate

Select the 'Submit' button when you are ready to send your form to Work and Income. The Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate will be sent electronically via HealthLink.



If you want to print a copy of the Work and Income Work Capacity medical certificate, select 'Print' at the end of your submitted form, remembering to select your default printer.

# Capacity to Work

#### Capacity to Work

Does the person have a health condition, injury or disability that presents a Yes barrier/limitation to work?










# b. Accessing parked WINZ Form from Profile for Mac


